Potential Providence Indoor Racer -

The second running of the Providence Indoor Race couldn't wait a year. After a successful event in March racing will return to the floor of the Dunkin Donuts Center in Providence on Friday and Saturday December 4 & 5. The event to be named the "Coffee Cup" will once again feature the TQ Midget and Sr. Champ Karts.

The management of the hall was very please with the event in March and despite having the NCAA Tournament in March of 2010 was able to find a date for the event in December of this year to keep the tradition of a mid Winter alive in Providence for years to come.

Both nights of racing will feature heat races, consolations and features for both divisions. A full feature purse for both divisions will be paid out each nights. Time trials that will be run on Friday will be used to line-up the heat races for both nights.

Entries for the event will be limited to 48 TQ Midgets and 42 Champ Karts. This is a slight increase from the March event and will allow more racers the opportunity to compete. Those who made a feature in March will have the first rights to an entry for this event and will have until September 4 to file their entry. After that date we fill the remaining entry spots accordingly. Anyone who is not included in the accepted entries will have their money refunded. The final deadline for entries is October 30.

As was the case in March we may have to limit the amount of people in the pit area. To insure that all racers and crew members gain access we will do a pre-sale for pit passes. Along with your entry form you will see a pre-sign sheet for pit passes included in this package. Please fill this form out and return it with a check or money order. If you do not know the names of people that will be coming at this time you can pay for the pit passes with your entry and fax the form over at a later date. This will be the only time we will accept a check for pit passes. After the cut off date and at the event cash will be required.

At the event all cars must unloaded and moved inside the building upon arriving at the center. Please be prepared to bring all tools, tires, spare parts and such inside the building with you. Your trailer will be parked outside the building and may not be readily accessible.

Those looking for hotel rooms will find a great rate of \$79 per night at the Hilton in Providence. The hotel is the closest hotel to the arena and is within walking distance. Check our website www.aarn.com for more information and to reserve your rooms.

John Holland from New England Racing Fuels with Sunoco will be the official fuel provider for the event. All fuel tanks must again arrive empty.

Rules for the event will be the same as past indoor events. A tentative event schedule is included with this letter. Be sure when entering to include an e-mail where you can be reached for update in the schedule and about the event.
